No. 2867-For. /11B-6/83—4th May 1984.—Whereas by notification No. 3640 For., dated the 6th June 1978 published at page 1361 of Part I of the "Calcutta Gazette" dated the 13th July 1978, the Governor was pleased to declare his intention to constitute the forest lands covering an approximate area of 1330-10 sq. kms. and comprising reserve forest blocks and compartments, in the district of 24-Parganas, more fully described in the Schedule below (hereinafter referred to as the said lands) as a National Park to be called the "Sunderbans National Park" for the purpose of protecting, propagal-1 ing and developing wild life therein;

And whereas more than two months from the date of such proclamation have elapsed for preferring claim, as required under clause (b) of section 21 of the Wild Lite (Protection) Act, 1972, (53 of 1972), (hereinafter referred to as the said Act);

And whereas no claim has been preferred under section 19 of the said Act;

And whereas all rights in respect of the said lands have been vested in the State Government :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (4) of section 35 of the said Act, the Governor is pleased hereby to specify in the Schedule below the limits of the said lands comprising the reserve forest blocks and compartments and declare that with effect from the 14th May 1984, the same shall be a National Park to be called the "Sunderbans National Park" for the said purpose.


