5.01 Seizure of Wildlife and Wildlife articles in West Bengal

Control of illegal trade in wildlife articles poses a major challenge to the Forest Department of West Bengal. Due to the geographic location of West Bengal and the prevailing socio-economic scenario of the region, West Bengal has become a major transit point in the movement of the illicit wildlife and its articles. It is evident from the series of seizures that the Dooars and the Terai region of North Bengal seems to offer a viable route to the miscreants involved in illicit wildlife article trade. The North-East and Bhutan seems to be the origin and the produces are destined largely to China via Nepal.

The Wildlife Wing of the West Bengal Forest Department, in co-ordination with other enforcement agencies like the Wildlife Crime Control Bureau, the Police Department, Customs authorities, etc. keeps a strict vigil to prevent such activities. Of late, the Wildlife Wing has been successful in apprehending a number of offenders involved in this trade that has helped in busting of illegal rackets involved in such activities, both in the North Bengal and in Kolkata.

6.02 Conservation Schemes & Projects:


The Wildlife Wing is implementing various State Plan Schemes, Centrally Sponsored Schemes for conservation of wildlife and their habitat in the State. The various Schemes and Projects implemented by this Wing is as following:

- 1. State Plan Schemes: Every year fund is received under this scheme for creation and maintenance of plantations, forest protection, timber operation, control of poaching, wildlife conservation in various national parks and sanctuaries, infrastructure development and publicity. For CSS-Project Tiger, 40% share from Non-recurring and 50% share from recurring cost is contributed from the State.
- **2. National Parks & Sanctuaries Schemes:** This is 60:40 Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of different national parks and sanctuaries in this State. The fund is being provided for habitat development, protection, infrastructure development, Research and Monitoring, awareness generation and eco-development.
- **3. Project Tiger:** This scheme is implemented in Buxa Tiger Reserve and Sundarban Tiger Reserve. Govt. of India provides 60% funds for non-recurring expenditures and 50% for recurring expenditures. The State Govt. contributes 50% of the fund from State Plan for recurring expenditures and 40% of the fund for non-recurring expenditures.
- **4. Project Elephant:** This is 60:40 Centrally Sponsored Scheme for conservation of wild elephant population in the State. The fund is provided for habitat development, infrastructure development, protection, reducing man-elephant conflict and awareness generation specially in Eastern Dooars Elephant Reserve and Mayurjharna Elephant Reserve.
- **5.** Conservation & Management of Sundarban Biosphere Reserve: This is 60:40 Centrally Sponsored Scheme for plantation, protecting eco-development activities of Sundarban Biosphere Reserve.
- **6.** Conservation and Management of Sundarban Mangroves: This is 60:40 Centrally sponsored Scheme for Conservation and Management of mangroves in Sundarbans and includes mangrove plantation, protection infrastructure support and eco-development works.
- 7. Conservation and Management of Wetlands: This is a new scheme for Wetland Conservation and is 60:40 Centrally Sponsored Scheme. In this state three wetlands Ahiron Beel, Rasik Beel and Santragachi Jheel has been identified for funding by Govt. of India. In addition to Sundarbans the scheme includes wetland conservation and eco restoration measures and eco-development activities.
- **8. Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF):** Rural Infrastructure Development fund as loan from NABARD is being utilized for undertaking various developmental works for the development of Infrastructure especially for the communities residing in and around the forest.
- 9. Rashtriya Krishi Vikash Yojana (RKVY): A new Additional Central Assistance scheme to incentivise States to draw up plans for their agriculture sector more

- comprehensively, taking agro-climatic conditions, natural resource issues and technology into account, and integrating livestock, poultry and fisheries more fully.
- **10. Intensification of Forest Management (IFM):** This is a new scheme for protection of forests, fire management and Infrastructure development in the State with 75% funding from Govt. of India and 25% contribution by the State Govt.
- **11. Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management And Planning Authority** (CAMPA): Guidelines for establishing CAMPAs in the States/UTs and putting in place a funding mechanism for enhancing forest and tree cover and conservation and management of wildlife by utilising funds received towards Compensatory Afforestation, Net Present Value (NPV), etc.



8.01 Training and Awareness programmes on Wildlife

Awareness generation on wildlife conservation, is the major thrust area of the wildlife administration of West Bengal. The targeted segments include school children, members of the judiciary, parallel enforcement agencies like the Police Department, Customs, the military, NGOs and even prisoners serving jail sentences. It is an accepted fact that the rise in awareness levels act as a catalyst towards the reduction of wildlife crimes.

Apart from the general awareness generation programmes, the Wildlife Wing also organizes specific training programmes for sensitization and skill up gradation of the staff and officers of the Wildlife Wing, as well as those of the veterinary officers associated with this wing. The training programme also aims at bringing together various NGOs working in the field of wildlife conservation by exchange of ideas, experiences and knowledge on curbing illegal wildlife trade. (Training on legal issues for various law enforcement agencies was organized to strengthen the collaboration between Wildlife Wing and various wildlife law enforcement agencies.) Large no. of Training programmes were organized for forest staff, FPC/EDC members and NGOs regarding census operation of wild animals.

Important Events of 2023-24

Phase - IV Tiger Estimation 2023-24:

In 2023-24 session, during the months of November & December 2023 and January & February 2024, in line with Phase-IV monitoring protocol of NTCA, the Sundarban Tiger Reserve Division carried out camera trapping exercise to monitor the tiger population in the Indian Sundarban. A total of 105 tigers were identified from the entire Sundarbans Landscape. The counting of Total Adult Individuals is based on ocular estimation method. Hence, there may be chances of few human errors. Cubs are not considered here for Total Adult individuals counting.

7th Buxa Bird Festival 2024

Buxa Bird Festival is a unique event being organized by the Directorate of Forests, Government of West Bengal under the aegis of Buxa Tiger Conservation Foundation since 2017. This festival offers an opportunity to explore the avifaunal diversity and natural resources along with the rich biodiversity and wilderness of Buxa Tiger Reserve. Resource persons from field of ornithology, nature lovers are invited for the festival. Application is also invited from person persons for participating in the festival & participation fees @ of Rs. 10,000 per person is charged. Buxa Bird festival was organized during 6th to 9th January, every year since inception. Since 2017, different bird species were documented as listed below.

Second Sundarban Bird Festival (2nd SBF, January 2024):

Sundarban Tiger Reserve and South 24 Parganas Division under the guidance of Wildlife Wing of the West Bengal Forest Department has organized the 2nd Sundarban Bird Festival on 17th to 20th January, 2024 with the objective of bringing in awareness about the conservation of Avifauna in Sundarbans. Almost 4000 sq km of the Indian Sundarbans is covered by the boat transect method. 6 birding teams have been selected on random basis for 6 different routes, namely- Basirhat; Sajnekhali; National Park East; National Park West; Matla and Kalas. These teams are guided by the resource persons, team leaders and forest staff. Through the adverse weather condition of 2 days bird trail, 145 bird species have been recorded with more than 8500 number of bird counts by the 6 birding teams, only by the boat transect from this Ramsar Site of international importance. Based on the State of Indian Birds Report (SoIB) 2023, 14 species of threatened birds were recorded in this two-day bird trail. After the panel discussion on 20th January, 2024 the recent threats were addressed, viz. Ecotourism and resultant disturbances; Distribution of Certain Species; Composition of Species in Plantation areas; Habitat Disturbances due to fishing and Non-Native Species Removal inside forests.



13th and 14th Meeting of the State Board for Wildlife

The 13th and 14th meeting of the State Board for Wildlife (SBWL) was held on 5th September, 2023 and 6th December, 2023 respectively, in the Conference Hall, 6th Floor, Aranya Bhawan.



Annual count of Water Birds

The annual count of water birds including the migratory birds in different wetlands of the State was conducted during January to February, 2024. Many NGOs, Nature Lovers, Bird Watchers and Naturalists involved during census.

Publication of Otter Status Report, 2023:

The Sundarbans is unique mangrove ecotone landscape with the tag of the UNESCO World heritage site and it is a renowned Ramsar site. Sundarban Tiger Reserve (STR) is the integral part of the Sundarbans, with a good number of tigers, co-habiting with other fauna. The present work was based on the data from camera trap exercise of tiger estimation between December 2021 to January 2023 which is held only during the winter. It is important to note that, not a single picture of Smooth-Coated Otters or Eurasian Otters was observed through camera trapping in the study area within the study period, which requires further intervention. Out of the total 573 trap camera points, 45 points depict the presence of Asian Small clawed otters which include 84 trapped photographs with a minimum estimated total of 211 individuals with varying group size. Mean group size for the species was recorded 2.51 (S.E. = 0.145) with the maximum sighting from the Core areas of STR. This research is basically focused on the spatial distribution and activity pattern of the vulnerable Asian Small-Clawed Otters (Aonyx cinereus Illiger, 1815) in the territory of STR (2584.89 sq. KM). Frequency based GIS map is constructed for better understanding of the zone of detection and spatial distribution. Activities of the otters were high at dawn, morning and at dusk while the sun set, recorded from the camera trap data. This is the first such intensive research work on the globally vulnerable Asian Small-Clawed otters from the West Bengal Forest Department.

Saltwater Crocodile Estimation (January, 2024):

Saltwater crocodiles are one of the apex predators in the Sundarban landscape and they play an important role in maintaining the health of the aquatic ecosystem. Saltwater crocodiles are an important indicator species of the health of the aquatic ecosystem. A detailed population assessment exercise was planned and conducted during the month of January, 2024 (17-20 January, 2024) to assess the population status of the saltwater crocodiles in Indian Sundarbans and to increase the understanding of the habitat ecology of the species. The exercise captured the direct and indirect sighting data of saltwater crocodiles, salinity, surface water and ambient temperature for basking, creek widths and other parameters like slope of the banks and vegetation. The number of saltwater crocodiles in Sundarbans has increased in comparison to the previous exercise that was held in 2012. Total direct and indirect sighting along the transect length of 1115 kilometers was 168 for the whole of Sundarban Biosphere Reserve. The estimated number of saltwater crocodiles in Indian Sundarbans is between a minimum of 204 up to 234.
